Tennis Australia has an urgent priority to lift its national level of player development and to drive this priority seeks to appoint a National Director of Player Development.

This is a new position as a result of the current re-structure of its player development activities. The appointee will be responsible for its future role and direction in consultation with the President and Board.

We seek a person who can bring a change and revitalisation to the player development area. The individual will have demonstrated strong leadership ability at a senior level, the capacity to "see the big picture", identify priorities and work, at times, with high profile sports men and women.

A background in tennis as a player, coach or administrator would be an advantage, however, people with outstanding and proven leadership qualities interested in a challenge and well skilled in strategic formulation and implementation are encouraged to apply.

Tennis Australia's current expenditure on player development is approximately \$5 million per annum directed through its Davis Cup, Fed Cup and Junior teams and its professional tournaments, junior tournaments, coaching and training, overseas tours, player grants and grants to assist Member Association player development programs.

The Director will be responsible for the total budget and for maximising returns on this investment in player development.
